

SEEDS THAT FLOURISH

One Campus Plus is a campaign to raise the extra funding needed so that all of our pupils can unlock their potential. Whether their abilities align with academic, sporting or artistic pursuits, we want to continue to nurture a fertile landscape for learning where everyone flourishes.

With this in mind, our aim is to enhance the new campus with the following extra facilities, fittings and features:

 A new Sports Pavilion with views across the playing fields, the new 3G pitch and the existing all-weather pitches. This building would be used by all pupils, and provide modern changing facilities for our home and visiting teams.


We have always planned to refurbish the current outfield pavilion, and one day to completely rebuild it. However, with support through the One Campus Plus campaign, we would be able to bring forward the plans for a new Pavilion as part of the current building programme, alleviating future disruption and utilising the funds earmarked for the refurbishment to help meet the costs of the new build.



- 2. Undercover sports facilities increased to 7,500m², by constructing a Canopy to cover our new tennis and netball courts. This will improve access and wider use of the sports facilities for all, including our junior pupils.
- 3. A surround area to the planned 3G pitch, including pitch-side dugouts and facilities.
- 4. An additional AstroTurf pitch to further improve the access to sport for all pupils, all year round.
- 5. Enhancements to the new Prep School play space to make it an exceptional communal environment for our younger pupils.



- 6. Contemporary furniture and fittings, in particular for the world-class Shared Sixth Form Centre and Music School. We have an opportunity to style these new spaces with state-of-the-art IT and furnishings that suit the varied activities they will support.
- 7. Planting and landscaping in external areas to enhance the established campus and create plenty of tranquil, themed green places and attractive courtyards.
- 8. Specially commissioned artwork to inspire our students and reflect the identities of our schools, celebrating their unique relationship based on shared values.



STEPS THAT SHAPE THE FUTURE

Now that the £41.25 million building programme is underway, it is clear that we have an opportunity to create a truly exceptional campus for our pupils and the wider Warwick community; a campus that not only provides a new home for King's High, but also has the capacity to deliver an extra level of benefits. An additional £4 million is needed to fully maximise the potential of the new site and ensure that all the new buildings, walkways and green spaces are finished to our highest aspirations.

As a Foundation, we also recognise our responsibility to ensure that the King's High that was, is very much a part of the fabric and feeling of the new building's classrooms, cloisters and courtyards. In making the transition, as part of One Campus Plus we plan to reflect the School's unique heritage by:


- Creating a new version of the King's High story, similar to the one currently on display in the Octagon building and prominently featured in one of the new School's social spaces.
- Commissioning an appropriate artistic tribute that recognises the important place of Landor House in the School's history.

Transforming the iconic Blue Door into a sympathetic design feature within the new site.






FOCUS THAT FLOWS


BENEFITS THAT GO BEYOND THE BRIEF

The benefits of bringing the Foundation family of Schools together are extensive. They represent our commitment to enhancing the educational experience of all our pupils and generating positive outcomes for the wider Warwick community.

The building project includes:

- The new King's High educational buildings, providing a stunning new home for single-sex teaching and extensive extra-curricular collaboration. The new school will also include a dedicated Innovation Centre.
- A new Sixth Form Centre for King's High and Warwick School, where teaching remains separate, but curriculum enrichment and social activities can be shared.
- A purpose-built, high-tech Music School for King's High and Warwick Preparatory School, including practice rooms and performance spaces.
- Improvements to the Bridge Sports Centre, grass pitches and nearby landscaping.
- 3G pitch and netball / tennis courts.
- A new, purpose-built play space for the Prep School.
- Increased parking facilities and enhanced traffic management.





THE PLUS FACTOR

The £41.25 million building programme to create a single, outstanding campus for our family of schools is the largest capital investment that the Foundation has made in new facilities. One Campus Plus is a campaign to raise a further £4 million, enabling us to maximise the potential of the new site and ensure that the project delivers our highest aspirations for a truly exceptional environment in which to learn, work and play.
